ABOUTSIS

Established in 2007, Singapore International School (SIS) is the only co-ed boarding school with a single largest campus International School in Mumbai. The school is situated on a green 10 acre campus with modern amenities, playing fields, indoor badminton courts, amphitheatre and swimming pool. Mumbai, a vibrant and multicultural city of 20 million and the financial hub of India, is home to many leading multinational organizations. SIS is the school of choice for families seeking top-quality education for their children.

SIS is intentionally set up as a signature school for 500 students from pre-school to grade 12 with an academic faculty of 100 staff in order to promote individualized learning. Nearly 30 percent of the students are boarders, and the school provides them with outstanding pastoral care and support. All students have access to a variety of extra-curricular and enrichment programmes like Round Square, International Award for Young People (IAYP). SIS students have a designated daily sports and games time alongside their PE lessons when they can play sport and engage in music, dance or arts and crafts. The school participates in inter-school competitions at the national and international level in the arts, sports and Model United Nations.

ACADEMIC OVERVIEW

The school offers an integrated and comprehensive academic program. Grade 1 to 5 follows the Singaporean curriculum within the framework of the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Program (IBPYP), using a Reggio Emilia approach for our younger learners. The IBPYP leads into Grades 7-8 where students follow a Cambridge Pre-IGCSE, moving to IGCSE in Grade 9 and 10. In the final two years SIS students follow the rigorous International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP). The whole academic program includes enrichment, information literacy, special education needs, personal and career counselling and a range of challenging activities and competitions. Throughout the school, the academic and co-curricular programmes promote individualization of learning and the holistic development of each child. IBDP students choose six subjects: three at Standard Level (SL) and three at Higher Level (HL), as well as completing a 4,000 word Extended Essay, Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course and a Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) programme as part of their IB diploma.

Integrity in College and University Application

All students at SIS from Grades 9 through 12 are supported by a dedicated team of college counsellors. Each student is mentored and guided to apply to a limited number of relevant universities. Our success rate in receiving offers and feedback shows that our approach to university admissions is well received by admissions teams. SIS students understand and adhere to the school's integrity in application policy. Given our close working relationships with students, SIS counsellors provide detailed individualized recommendations that best represent our students. SIS has an excellent track record in terms of university placements and scholarships.

APPLICATIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS CLASS OF 2023

78 graduates from the Class of 2024 put forth 1200 applications to over 15 countries worldwide. Most popular being USA, UK, Canada and India while some applications were also sent to Australia, New Zealand, France, Hong Kong, Singapore, Netherlands, Germany, Italy, UAE and Ireland. Many students achieved their dream university acceptances from the most prestigious Universities in the world!

Our students applied to a plethora of courses like Engineering, Medicine, Law, International Relations, Economics, Mathematics, Film & Music Production, Management, Computer Science, Culinary Art, Environmental Sciences & Urban Sustainability, Fine Art and Illustration, Game Design Development, Psychology etc. This reflects the diverse and eclectic interests of the SIS students and the support provided by the School to pursue a variety of careers.

The outstanding scholarship offers received by the Class of 2024 amounts to over \$ 8.34 million US dollars spread over 4 years like the Chancellor's Award, International Scholar Award, President's Scholarship, Global Excellence Scholarship, Creative Achievement Award and so on. 55% of the students in the Class of 2024 have got scholarships from highly coveted Universities. Also, notable is the large percentage been accepted to their top choice of Universities along with being awarded Scholarships.

SIS RESULTS

- SIS has been authorized to offer the IB Diploma Programme since April 2007 and was among the first 32 schools in India to offer IBDP
- In May 2024, 78 students appeared for the IB Diploma examination, out of which one student scored a Perfect 45 and four students scored 44
- With a score of 45 being the highest, close to 20% of our students have scored 40 or above in May 2024
- Close to 70% of our students have scored 35 or more
- 89.74% of our students have scored better than the world average
- SIS students has received a Perfect 45 in May 2024, 2022, 2021, 2018 & 2017
